What You'll Need

- Yarn
- Knitting needle
- Embroidery needle
- Embroidery thread
- Stuffing
- Scissors

Knitted Square Bunnies Guide

1. Knit yourself a square of fabric or just buy a sheet of fabric and cut out a square
2. Sew a triangle into the top half of the square as illustrated above
3. Pull the thread tight and push a pinch of soft stuffing into the fabric
4. Sew the body of the bunny tightly shut and push in more stuffing
5. Sew the bottom of the bunny closed and make a fluffy pom-pom tail as described in the tutorial

It really is one of the easiest sewing projects we've ever come across and a wholly brilliant project for newcomers and first-timers. It's almost impossible to go wrong as the whole idea is that every little bunny you create will be somewhat unique – one-of-a-kind gifts for family and friends, whatever the occasion!
