1. Uber & Taxify Taxis on Naivasha Road. Uber have blacked out this area on the Uber App so that drivers don't park there however we are having the same issue with Taxify now. Taxify have not responded to any of our mails to date. This has been escalated to the transport department.
2. Overgrown property outside Inyanga, after many meetings and emails we have now confirmed that this piece of property is owned by Inyanga themselves. Thank you to the residents for cleaning and maintaining this area going forward.
3. The K60 and K73 maintenance continues to be unresolved. However I have now managed to get hold of the director for provincial road maintenance. Hoping to be onsite with them on the 6 April 2017

Adjusted Budget

- R60 million for JRA to procure material for pothole repairs
- R28 million in salaries for JRA
- R49.2 million for Pikitup
- R15 million for emergency storm water interventions
- Complete 1841 housing units in this financial year.
- R219 million to JOSHCO inner city building for rentals
- R38 million for the Anti-Corruption Unit
- R5 million to complete the skills audit.
- R4, 3 million to have 5 clinics with extended working hours.
- R2 million for the construction of homeless shelters
- R5million to complete the Shared Industrial Production Facility in Alexandra.

 - a. The City remains committed to honouring existing contractual commitments under the *Jozi@Work*.
 - b. While stressing that work opportunities provided under the existing *Jozi@Work* programme are of a temporary nature, no work opportunities have been withdrawn as a result of the decision to revamp the programme. All community members currently employed under the *Jozi@Work* will continue working under the programme until completion of their contracts."

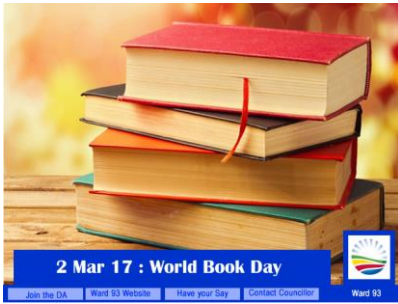

A Team of ladies will be competing in the Muddy Princess Obstacle course on the 19th Mar 2017.

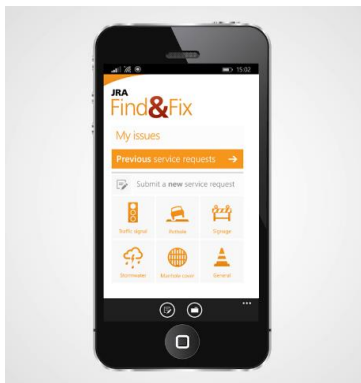

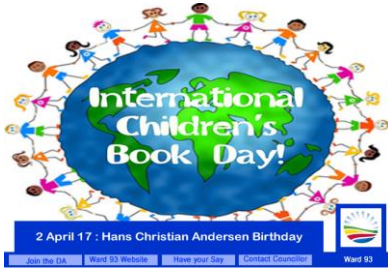
