What we all know is that Rome wasn't built in a day and that forward is always forward. The Mayor said,

"change has taken root in our city".

Some highlights:

1. Clinics

* 5 clinics have been identified as priorities to introduce drug rehabilitation services to communities.

* 13 clinics already offer extending working hours.

* 87 000 patients have visited these clinics in these extended hours.

2. JMPD

* Since the local election in 2016, Our JMPD officers have made over 20000 arrests.

Interesting is that between 2009 – 2011, 20000 arrests

were not made.

3. Debt

*In taking over this government, there was an inherited debt of R17 billion with R5 billion due this year.

4. Corruption

*R18 billion worth of fraud is being investigated. This money could have built all the backlog of RDP houses, built multi-purpose centers etc.

5. Traffic lights

* We can report that the implementation of this policy at 120 of the busiest traffic intersections has reduced traffic light down time by 72%.
